## GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR Ph.D. - 2016 ADMISSIONS

### Eligibility Criteria:

- 55% marks/5.5 CPI for General category in Master Degrees (2 years full time programme)
- 50% marks or 5.0 CPI for SC/ST/SEBC categories in Master Degrees (2 years full time programme)

### Admission Process:

**Step: 1 Shortlist for Written Test:** To verify the prescribed duly completed and signed application form (hardcopy) with all necessary self-attested documents. If eligible, candidate will be short listed for the written test.

### Step: 2 Written Test:

Eligible candidates having Valid GATE score/ any Research Fellowship from CSIR/UGC/NBHM or DST/ qualified UGC-CSIR NET or SLET or equivalent are to be called directly for interview.

### Step: 4 Final Admission:

Final admission based on the verification of all the relevant documentary evidences and payment of fees as per schedule.

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- The cutoff marks in the written test for the candidates belonging to General category will be the average of the marks scored by all the appeared candidates in the written test. Whereas 10% relaxation in the cutoff marks of General Category will be considered for candidates belonging to SC/ST/SEBC category.
  
- After conduction of written exam, the top 10 eligible candidates including GATE candidates of the declared merit list in each discipline of Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering & Mechanical Engineering and top 06 eligible candidates of the declared merit list in Humanities (English, Sociology), Mathematics, and Physics & Applied Chemistry will be called for the Interview.
  
- The Minimum marks to be secured in the Interview will be 50 for the candidates belonging to the General category whereas 45 for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/SEBC category.
  
- Candidates belonging to SC/ST/SEBC category would be eligible for relaxations as per the existing State Government norms. In the absence of the reserved category candidate, the respective seats will be converted in to the General category seats.
  
- Merely satisfying the eligibility criteria does not any kind of guarantee to be called for written test/Interview/allotment of admission.
  
- The above guidelines are subject to modification whenever found necessary by the Institute. If a dispute will arise regarding any of the above guidelines, the decision of the Competent Authority of the Institute shall be final and binding to all.
