

Norms for Exit Degree - B.Sc. (Engineering)

Approved in 17th Meeting of Academic Council held on 23rd November 2023 (Agenda Item No. 2023.4.12), and 22nd Meeting BoG, held on 05 February 2024 (Agenda Item No. 7.8)

Background

Several undergraduate students joining the Institute find it difficult to undergo rigorous academic programme due to various reasons like Family, Medical, etc., at the Institute are often faced with the prospect of having to leave the programme without obtaining a degree.

For that the Institute provides the option for such students to Exit program with B.Sc. Engineering with minimum requirements.

Minimum Graduation Requirements and Norms for B.Sc. (Engineering)

1. B.Sc. in Engineering will be given without any sub specialization.
2. This will only be an “Exit” degree and no separate admission will be offered into this program.
3. The graduation requirements for this degree will be lower and fairly flexible in order to enable students to exit comfortably with a degree (see Degree Requirements).
4. Any undergraduate student (including existing students) may apply for conversion to this program any time after the end of his / her fourth active semester.
5. A student opting for this program will typically not be permitted to convert back to the B.Tech. degree. In exceptional circumstances, the Chairman, Academic Council may approve re-conversion to B.Tech. upon recommendation of the Dean / Associate Dean, Academic Programmes.
6. This is completely exit programs in exceptional case, students are requested to complete their B.Tech. degree program.

Degree Requirements

1. A student opting to exit the institute with a B.Sc. (Engineering) degree will be required to complete at least 100 credits of coursework.
2. Registration and evaluation will be as per B.Tech. norms.
3. A student exiting via the B.Sc. (Engineering) should have spent at least 6 active semesters at the institute. Further, the maximum permissible duration to obtain this degree will be 6 years from the date of enrolment in the original B.Tech. program.
4. Fees and fee payment norms will be as applicable to B.Tech. students.
