INSTITUTE HIGHLIGHTS

Convocation 2024

IITRAM held its 6th Convocation Ceremony on August 05, 2024, in Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Auditorium Hall, Vastral, Ahmedabad. A total of 160 graduates were conferred degrees. Of this, 129 B. Tech, 21 M. Tech and 10 doctoral graduates received degrees. 6 students, 3 each in Civil and Electrical Engineering, were awarded B. Tech degree with Honours. 5 students in Electrical Engineering and four in Mechanical Engineering were awarded B. Tech degrees with Minors. The Chief Guest of this convocation ceremony was Prof. Barjor Mehta, the President and Acting Director of CEPT University.



Independence Day Celebration

IITRAM celebrated the 78th Independence Day on campus. The celebration was honored by the presence of the Director General, **Prof. B. N.
